



Participant Code of Conduct

Our Code of Conduct aims to create an encouraging, supportive and safe environment where all participants know what is expected of them and can work alongside each other in a positive and constructive way.

R&R reserves the right to withdraw a participant from the revision trip, at any time, where in the opinion of the Director, their presence is likely to prejudice the good order, discipline, kindness or safety of the revision trip.

In such an event, the participant will not be entitled to any refund, but will be invoiced by R&R for any costs, losses or expenses which R&R incurs or suffers as a result of the their behaviour.

The decision of the Director as to the conduct, itinerary and objectives of the revision trip is final.

Duty of Care

You will be under the supervision and instruction of R&R staff throughout the revision trip. All R&R staff have a duty of care and are required by law to act *in loco parentis*: all staff have to provide the same level of care as a parent would in the same circumstances.

As a participant, you will, at all times, co-operate with R&R's staff, including without limitation, any request relating to conduct, approach to tuition sessions and independent work, behaviour with others and punctuality.

Behaviour

At all times, each participant is expected to show respect to local people and their way of life. You should refrain from using bad language and engaging in disruptive or abusive behaviour, or any behaviour which is likely to cause irritation or offence.

You must show respect and consideration to other participants at all times. Behaviour should be compatible with learning, discipline, good order and kindness.

Any acts of bullying or violence, including behaviour that threatens the emotional wellbeing of any participant, will not be tolerated. R&R considers bullying to include any behaviour (spoken, electronic, physical or psychological) that intends to make another person feel hurt, humiliated or unhappy.

If there is anything you are unhappy about, you should let a member of staff know as soon as possible.

The Director's decision as to what constitutes unacceptable behaviour will be final and not subject to discussion or further review.

If the Director believes your approach to be unacceptable, where applicable, your Parent/Guardian will be contacted and arrangements will be made for your withdrawal from the revision trip.

Phones and Devices

R&R recognises the importance of mobile phones for communication with parents and friends during the revision trip, however, mobile phones are not allowed during tuition sessions, revision sessions, or at mealtimes, and are to be switched off during these times; if you have an urgent need to use your phone, you must seek permission.

To ensure a good night's rest for all participants, we ask that mobiles are turned onto silent at 10.30pm. No phone calls should be made after this time. If sharing a room with others, we ask you to minimise screen time after 10.30pm. Wi-Fi access is turned off from 10.30pm–8.00am.

Social media

We do not condone any sharing of images or information via social media that could jeopardise the running of the revision trip; the safety, privacy or wellbeing of other participants; or the reputation of R&R.

We ask that you think before you post anything on social media, stopping to seek advice if you're in doubt. Any inappropriate posts could result in a breach of good conduct, resulting in your removal from the revision trip.

Dress

Each participant must conform to acceptable and respectful standards of dress and presentation. When out in the local area as ambassadors of R&R, you must dress appropriately, taking general decency, local customs and religious beliefs into consideration.

Swimwear is only permitted around the pool.

Smoking

R&R does not permit smoking or vaping on the revision trip at any time, under any circumstances. Anyone caught smoking or vaping will be withdrawn from the revision trip.

Alcohol

The consumption of alcohol whilst on the revision trip is strictly forbidden for all participants, regardless of the laws and customs of the country itself.

For participants over the age of 18, you may only have alcohol (wine or beer) at the explicit invitation of R&R staff.

Anyone caught drinking alcohol without permission, regardless of age, will be immediately withdrawn from the revision trip.

Drugs

R&R has a zero-tolerance policy on drugs (other than those prescribed to participants for medical purposes). Any participant found possessing or using drugs, or misusing solvents, will face immediate removal from the revision trip.

Staff supervision

Outside of the venue, participants will be accompanied and supervised by R&R staff at all times, regardless of age. You are not allowed out of the venue without a member of staff. Any participant found to be breaking this rule will be withdrawn from the revision trip.

Relationships

No participant is allowed to receive visitors at the venue under any circumstances, or make arrangements to meet anyone outside of the venue.

Any participant engaged in sexual activity (within or outside of the venue), or found in a compromising situation, must expect to be removed from the revision trip.
